One More, One at a Time. Where is the One More? When I ask this question, it reminds me of the story of the Good Samaritan when they asked Jesus, "but who is my neighbor?" The answer is YES. Yes, THEY are your neighbor. Yes, THEY are the One More.

I heard a pastor once say, "Put your Yes on the table and God will put your ministry on the map." In 2004, the Board of Directors put a YES on the table with no expiration date and no boundaries. Since that time, God has continued to set our course and expand our territory, both deep and wide.

In 2022, our Board and Staff believe this map will include Clark and Crawford counties. The challenge in the current financial climate is making a commitment to a brick-and-mortar location. The vision for CHOICES next year is to develop a mobile model of ministry by partnering with organizations to host parenting classes and provide material assistance a couple of days a month. This will allow us to gage both community support and felt needs of the families on whom we will focus. To fulfill the mission of reaching surrounding counties, we will start with purchasing and customizing a van for hauling a mobile Blessing Boutique. The van will also serve as a rolling billboard advertising our services throughout Southern Indiana. A church in Charlestown is ready for us to use their parsonage for this endeavor and we believe the Lord has also opened a Crawford County connection. Our staff will begin recruiting and training new volunteers from churches in those communities to serve clients in each location. This part of our vision is sending us wide.

The next part of our vision for 2022 is sending us deep. But deep where? Deep into the enemy's territory of abortion misinformation. We know that statistically we are not reaching the number of abortion vulnerable women and men who live in the counties we serve. CHOICES is now investing more resources to reach moms and dads who are in the darkness and privacy of their homes and cars searching for abortion services. They need CHOICES to be in their path as they navigate an unplanned pregnancy. As they are searching online, we will invest heavily in making sure they find the

FUNDRAISING banquet



On Thursday, September 30, nearly 500 friends, old and new, gathered at Plantation Hall for our annual Fundraising Banquet. This year we incorporated a new model by soliciting businesses to underwrite the event, eliminated ticket costs, and recruited and trained table hosts. All these changes came from coaching sessions with our speaker, Kirk Walden, former member of Heartbeat International's Advancement Team.

Kirk literally wrote the book (binder) on successful banquets. He also wrote a book called, The Wall, which was our gift to attendees. A client video testimony highlighted Rachel, a client who had resisted pressure to abort and instead she found the hope,

Rose Condra, Executive Director, shared a ministry update and vision for 2022. She said, "If we were able to see hope in 2020, what would we see in 2021? Our staff knew there was uncertainty with the number of



clients we'd be able to reach, so we decided to "Focus on the One." Our "one more, one at a time," has amounted to 573 individuals receiving services in the past 12 months.

Kirk challenged guests to dig deep and provide for the needs of the ministry. He also incorporated the story of The Good Samaritan to ask supporters to make monthly gifts equal to two-day's wages. The message obviously resonated, and our current tally is an all-time record of \$195,000 in one-time gifts and monthly pledges. This is so far beyond what we asked or

imagined that our staff reviewed the spreadsheet a dozen times. All we can say is, "God is good and does good!"
